HUMAN PHILOSOPHIES

ATHEISM: no God AGNOSTICISM: don't know

ANIMISM: spirits are gods POLYTHEISM: many gods

MONOTHEISM: one God

DEISM: Creator can't control PANTHEISM: all is god THEISM: Creator can control PANENTHEISM: God is in all

EXISTENTIALISM: experience is god **HUMANISM**: man is god

RATIONALISM: reason is god MATERIALISM: only matter is real

DUALISM: two gods < good MYSTICISM: only spirit is real MONISM: matter & spirit are one
