 - Write down what you want your prayer life to look like
 - 5 minutes every day talk to God about whatever, anything, any time of day, any place, in any posture, eyes closed or open (discussion about 41 minutes in video)

 - On knees
 - Sitting
 - Standing
 - Lifting Hands
 - o On your face
 - Lying in bed (Psalm 63.6 When I remember You on my bed, I mediate on You in the night watches (discussion about 44 minutes in video)

- Write a short prayer (Not "Jesus wept." Maybe at least three sentences. Write it like you're going to read it to a child if you want. Doesn't have to be flowery or perfect or special. Just write it like you're talking to a friend.

- All He cares about is that you talk to Him, that you spend time with Him
